CCD Updates for the 2020-2021 School Year:

Applications are available at the Church entrances for the 2020-2021 CCD school year. Please apply as soon as possible.

Due to COVID-19 regulations, we do NOT have use of the school building for our classes. We are limited to Farrell Hall at this time.

The Sacramental classes (2nd Grade and 8th Grade) will be in face-to-face classes beginning on September 9th in the Hall classrooms.
